Mandatory Renewable Energy Target Review

Re the above and your Terms of Reference, could you please consider the following?

- (a) Encouragement of Additional Generation is curtailed by the Queensland Government who have placed a ceiling on the amount of electricity generated by domestic producers who also export to the Grid. This ceiling is supposedly based on the average household consumption but in reality is not even half of what an ordinary household requires in this modern age. This ceiling should be revised to be in line with the real amount required by a household. I suspect the Queensland Government has a hidden agenda for renewable energy, probably dictated to by the very large coal interests.
- (b) An alternative approach could include a review of the various State restrictions on domestic suppliers.
- (f) There appears to be little or no effort to capture the Methane Gas from Sewerage Systems. Local Councils have not been given incentives to utilise this waste.
- (i) (iii) Baselines for domestic generators should not be controlled by State Authorities.
- (j) (iv) The policy settings involving the States should be universal and not dictated to by new renewable influences
